This book is the mandatory summer reading assignment for all incoming 8th grade students

The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn by Mark Twain

Each student must complete a journal which outlines the novel. Journals must be neat, bright and colorful and should reflect three months of work. Specifically, journals must include

- a cover page - with the title, author and a drawing representing the book
- a table of contents - which reflects the journal entries
- an "About the Author" page - which gives information about the author of the book
- a summary of each chapter which may also contain vocabulary word, points of interest and/or questions about the chapter

In September, we will then discuss in detail the characters, plot formation setting and conflicts of the book.
